

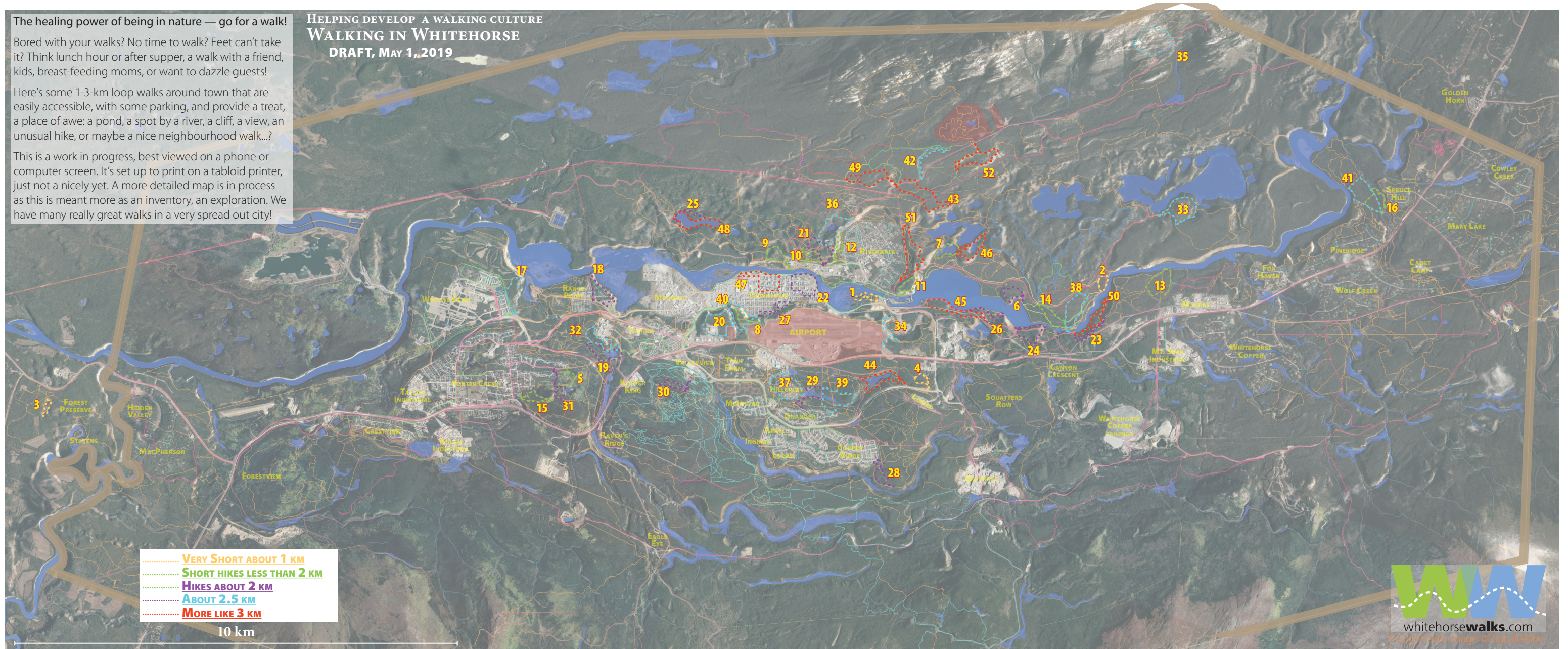
The healing power of being in nature — go for a walk!

VERY SHORT ABOUT 1 KM

- 1. Bert Law Loop 1.4**
Riverine, lots of berries, a hidden sanctuary
- 2. Canyon City 1.0**
Miles Canyon, tramway, old camp site, gold rush, Yukon River
- 3. Kettle Lake Loop 1**
A teaser in the forest preserve, more loops possible here
- 4. Rock Gardens 1.3**
Looking down on the climbing wall and the lower pond

SHORT HIKES LESS THAN 2 KM

- 5. Above Stinky Lake 1.9**
Look for eagles and moose
- 6. Above the boat launch 1.7**
Mostly in place, follow top of ridges surrounding this hill
- 7. Around Hidden Lake #2 1.6**
Introduction to Hidden Lakes trails
- 8. Baxter's Flats 1.7**
North end of airport over Two Mile Hill, Marwell

9. Behind Hospital 1.8

One day this will be part of the hospital's wellness repertoire

10. Crocus Ridge 1.7

Twists, turns, moderately gentle hills, great views, peaceful forest

11. Dam Hill 1.9

Fish Ladder, dam, Schwatka Lake, views, birds, sand and wind

12. Dunes on Crocus Hill 1.6

Sandy slopes, nice trails, a good workout, views, views, views

13. Hepburn-Basalt 1.9

American Laundry Road, Basalt Creek and 1898 Hepburn Tramway

14. Miles Canyon from ski parking 1.8

Get down to the Canyon, see the bridge

15. Way above Stinky Lake 1.6

I call this 'Grunt Hill', but the view is worth it

16. Wolf Creek creek 1.8

A delightful side trail right along the creek

HIKES ABOUT 2 KM

17. Above Eagle Bay 2.3

Amazing views over the confluence of river and creek

18. Above Marwell Flats 2.0

Peaceful view of the flats, Marwell and beyond

19. Around College Pond 2.0

Delightful pond, lots of plants, birds, bridges, McIntyre Creek

20. City Operations 2.3

This will be popular with the new workers coming here

21. Crocus Hill 2.3

Using gradual slopes to explore a maze of hilly trails

22. Downtown south 2.1

Sometime you just have to walk the streets

23. Hepburn Tramway, fix us 2.1

Partially covered by railway construction, part of Yukon River Trail

24. Leaving Miles Canyon 2.1

Have to figure out best trail up to the viewpoint

25. Long Lake east 2.0

Follows the shores of Long Lake

26. Lookout Hill 2.2

Views, bits of the Hepburn Tramway, with a peek at Ear Lake, ...

27. Lower Escarpment Loop 2.0

Edge of downtown, escarpment parks, Old Town, cemetery

28. Overlooking Arkell Wetlands 2.1

Tricky to find if not well-used in the winter but worth the views!

29. Paddy's Pond 2.1

Sandy hills, views, a pond, birds, frogs and kids

30. Rocky collective 2.1

Year-round city trails with old forest and narrow rocky canyon.

31. Shoreside Stinky Lake 2.1

Nice little lake, and lives up to its name

ABOUT 2.5 KM

32. Boreal Worlds Trail 2.5

Can we even find this old college trail or is it all built over?

33. Chadburn 2.5

It's hard to get short loops in this area

34. End of airport 2.5

Many old roads and trails, follows an easy way off escarpment

35. Fast Money 2.6

Rocky. to be explored more.

36. Grey Mountain Road Snowdump Pond 2.6

Dirt tracks, switchbacks, lake views, forest — with gentle hills

37. Hillcrest trail 2.4

Circle this 1950s neighbourhood, originally a US Airforce base

38. Miles Canyon from west parking 2.5

MacAuley Tramway, ski trails, and a suspension bridge

39. Orchid Alley boardwalks 2.6

Learn more about trails near Paddy's Pond

40. Spook Creek 2.5

This will be great with trail work: switchback, flats, creek, streets

41. Wolf Creek lookout 2.4

Long a local favorite, it's now partially wheelchair accessible

42. Yellowbrick/Woodcutter 2.5

Up a little valley, down an old road above the valley — nice

MORE LIKE 3 KM

43. A peek down at Hidden Lakes 3.4

The area above these lakes is nice. This is an intro...

44. Around Ice Lake 2.9 km

Viewpoints aalong this peaceful walk above the lake

45. Checking out the floatplanes 3.1 km

The edge of the lake, up to the escarpment, railway, telegraph line

46. Hidden Delight all 2.8

More glacial features, lots of views, good exercise

47. Library Loop 2.7

Waterfront, Shipyards Park, KDCC, library

48. Long Lake shore 2.7

A lovely windy, rooty, truly lake-side trail

49. Looking over the cemetery 2.9

Magnusson Red, Upper Bugaloo with a rocky hill at the ends. Help!

50. Lower loop 2.7

In a word, strenuous. Really neat, amazing forest, thick moss, ...

51. Powerline – Peewee – Heartbreak 3.3

Legendary hill, Hidden Lakes–Yukon River views

52. Two towers (really only one now!) 3.2

Tough, but with a bit of work will make this one of our neatest hikes

Eventually this will be more of a trail map, with starting locations, some sort of ratings and close-up maps.

Winter, summer trail prognosis may be added.
